



PRESENTING A TECHNICAL PAPER

Papers must be original and have no commercial or promotional purposes.

Both the abstracts and the papers can be submitted in Spanish or English.

Once the technical paper has been uploaded to the System, the following must be sent via email to congresos@iapg.org.ar:

- The paper authorization file signed by all authors.
 - A photo of the authors (size: 4x4), high-resolution (+780 pixels) in a .jpg file.
- The paper must be uploaded to the Congress System (<https://siscon.iapg.org.ar/>) in Microsoft Word format with a maximum of 25 (twenty five) pages, including tables, charts, appendix and bibliography. Sheet size must be A4 (single column) and follow this order:

- Abstract (400 words {max.} and 100 words {min.} summarizing the work and the conclusions reached)
- Introduction
- Development
- Conclusions
- Bibliography
- Short résumé, as per this model:

Degree obtained and University; Present position in the Company; Career experience (different companies he/she worked with). These must be preceded by the title in bold, upper case letter and centered (not underlined). Below, leaving a line spacing (lower case letter), name of Authors, Company they belong to and their email addresses must be included.

Model: TECHNICAL PAPER TITLE

Author/authors; company; e-mail address; Abstract; etc.

Font size: Times New Roman 11 for the technical paper's body and Times New Roman 12 only for the title. Drawings, charts and/or pictures inserted in the body must be jpg size, numbered and restricted to a maximum size of 17 x 25, 5 cm. Images must be inserted in the text, as applicable.



Captions must be clear and large in order to be legible and readable even if reduced to a 50%. Scanned pictures and/or drawings must be recorded with a minimum resolution of 200 dpi and the size required in the document.

Statistical graphs and diagrams must be in Microsoft Excel, preferably, to keep the vectorial format.

Abbreviations must be defined in the text upon first use and between brackets.

Do not use footnotes. The metric system to use will be SI (International System of Units), alternatively, the equivalent value in SI units must appear between brackets. Any reference, nomenclature and bibliography must appear at the end of the paper, as well as a short resume of the authors, as per the model provided.
